Introduction

Qualification:

A Non Domestic Energy Assessor (NDEA) is an individual who undertakes energy calculations, using approved Simplified Building Energy Model (SBEM) or Dynamic Simulation Modelling (DSM) software on commercial buildings. The calculations produce a commercial Energy Performance Certificate (EPC). All commercial buildings in the UK require an EPC before marketed as for sale or to let.

Upon successful completion of the NDEA training individuals are classed as qualified. Once qualified you are eligible to join our government approved certification scheme free of charge. Only individuals who are registered with an approved certification body are able to produce legally valid EPCs.

Who Can Apply?

Candidates for the NDEA Level 3 and 4 course are not required to have any previous experience as it is designed for new entrants.
