Now they are looking to use Energy Certificates to deliver on the aims of the Clean Growth Strategy by identifying new trigger points for when an Energy Certificate will be required and how we can improve them to ensure they contain "good quality data", that they are reliable, accurate and up to date.

Elmhurst was delighted to see the release of the 'EPCs in Buildings call for evidence' which aims to gain feedback on how Energy Certificates currently work and suggestions for improvements. Elmhurst's Technical Director, Stuart Fairlie will be using this time to present the three main areas included within the call for evidence (Quality, Encouraging Action, and Availability), and will also provide an overview of Elmhurst's response.
